The CFUW Brampton Legacy Award recognizes female secondary school graduates selected by their schools for their academic excellence and full participation in student and community activities. The award provides financial support to young women as they pursue further studies at a Canadian university. The CFUW Brampton Legacy Fund is held by the Brampton and Caledon Community Foundation (BACCF). The BACCF distributes the CFUW Brampton Legacy Award annually, continuing a more than 50-year advocacy for Brampton young women.

As a teacher, if you feel one of your female students that qualifies for this award, please consider putting your student's name forth to receive a **\$200** bursary award.

Award Guidelines

- Recipient must be a female.
- Recipient must be a Brampton resident.
- Recipient must be enrolled and graduating from a Brampton-based school either from the Dufferin Peel Catholic District or Peel District School Boards.
- Recipient must have been accepted and will be attending a Canadian university.
- Only one award recipient per school.
- No late submissions will be accepted. Deadline is **May 31, 2026**
- Applications must be confirmed and submitted by a teacher or other school administrator.
- Award criteria can include but not limited to academic performance, school/community service, leadership skills and financial assistance.
- Award cheques will be distributed during graduation ceremony, unless otherwise coordinated.
